

## Chukat - Balak Answers

1. To train us in the understanding of holiness.
2. The truth of HaShem is forgotten and replaced by man's traditions
3. When the Torah is replaced by man's doctrines the Torah becomes ineffectual.
4. The ruler interpreted healing as an act of work
5. The Shabbat was created for man, man was not created for the Shabbat. Therefore, to heal a man who is created in the image of HaShem is a greater mitzvah than doing nothing to heal a person in need on the Shabbat.
6. The bronze serpent was for any individual, who had been bitten by a fiery serpent. When the individual looked upon the bronze serpent he or she was healed.
7. The generation spoken of in 2Kings 18:4 has turned the bronze serpent into an idol
8. By replacing the Torah with man made doctrines
9. *Shemot* 33:20 states that looking on HaShem's face causes death
10. HaShem covered Moshe with His hand as He passed, than allowed Moshe to look at Him from behind
11. Through Yeshua
12. The Angel of the LORD
13. *Judges* 13:17- 22 states that The Angel of The Lord ascended on the sacrificial fire built by Manoah and his wife. In fact, after seeing the Angel of the Lord Manoah and his wife believed they had seen God
14. *Shemot* 23:21 states that the Angel of the Lord has HaShem's name in him.
15. *Shoftim* 2:1-2 or *Judges* 2:1-2
16. The word testament is more accurately translated covenant. Therefore, when Yeshua speaks of a new testament He is referring to a covenant.

Therefore, in Mt 26:28, Mr 14:24, Lu 22:20 Yeshua is establishing a covenant.

17. Yeshua's mission was to place the Torah in our minds and our hearts as Heb 8:10 states **"For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:"**
18. Philippians 2:10 which states **"That at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;"**
