1. Lack of Commitment to HaShem's will
2. Yisrael's failure to enter the promised land the first time was caused by a lack of commitment. Therefore, the generation who failed to enter the promised land was not useful in the fulfillment of HaShem's will at that time.
3. He changed the timing with which the descendants would enter the Promised Land
4. During the 40 years the Children of Yisrael were required to rely on HaShem for everything. Therefore, they learned commitment to HaShem.
5. Total commitment helps believers overcome the obstacles they encounter while doing HaShem's will
