1. In ancient Yisrael what was the main difference that separated Yisraelite worship from other forms of worship?
2. How does the construction of the tabernacle demonstrate that HaShem wanted people to serve him voluntarily?
3. How does the plan of the tabernacle differ from the plan of pagan temples?
4. How does seeing the tabernacle in heaven demonstrate that HaShem cared about and wanted to be active in his peoples lives?
5. How does the construction of the tabernacle demonstrate that HaShem wanted to be active in the lives of His people?
6. How does the mobility of the tabernacle demonstrate that HaShem cared about and wanted to be actively involved in peoples lives?
7. How does the tabernacle accurately represent the relationship HaShem establishes with people through Yeshua?

*Even though our relationship with HaShem through the work of Yeshua closely resembles the work and function of the tabernacle, it should not be considered a replacement for the current or future importance of the temple or tabernacle. Revelations 21:3 states **“I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God *is* with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God Himself shall be with them, *and be their God.*”** (KJV)
