

Tzav Answers

1. Moshe
2. *Shemot 33:11* states “**the LORD spoke unto Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend.**” and *Shemot 4:16* states “**And he shall be thy spokesman unto the people: and he shall be, even he shall be to thee instead of a mouth, and thou shalt be to him instead of God.**” Both of these passages indicate that HaShem had given Moshe an anointing that was greater than any other individuals anointing in Yisrael.
3. According to *Vayikra 8:6* the first step in cleansing Aaron and his sons was to wash them.
4. To clothe him with the holy garments
5. To anoint Aaron and his sons with the fragrant oil of the tabernacle and the blood of the sacrifice.
6. *Vayikra 8:14* states that a bullock for the sin offering was the first step in spiritual cleansing
7. The act of placing the blood of the sacrifice on the tip of their right ear, and upon the thumbs of their right hands, and upon the great toes of their right feet:
8. This represented hearing, doing, and walking in HaShem's will
9. Seven complete days. At the beginning of the eighth day they were clean
10. HaShem's desire for every individual to be sanctified physically as well as spiritually.
